

NSS Orientation Programme 2026

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Aarupadai Veedu Institute of Technology (AVIT) ISR Cell a constituent institution of Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (Deemed to be University), organised an Orientation Programme for the newly admitted first year students on 06.08.2026 at Auditorium. Senior NSS volunteers of the institution also addressed the gathering, sharing their personal experiences of participating in NSS camps and activities, thereby giving the new students a first-hand perspective on the scheme. Senior NSS volunteers shared their experiences from previous camps and activities, motivating the first year students to join the scheme. An interactive question-and-answer session followed, during which the Programme Officer and volunteers addressed queries from the students regarding enrolment, activities, and time commitment. The session concluded with an on-the-spot enrolment drive for interested students, coordinated by the volunteers.
