REPORT ON “FOSTERING WOMEN’S ENTREPREUSHIP THROUGH SKILLS TRAINING” at ARUNKUNDRAM

As part of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) initiative, the Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) Cell of Aarupadai Veedu Institute of Technology (AVIT), Chennai, organized a Skill Development Program for Women on Paper Bag Making on 8th November 2025 at the UBA-adopted village, Arunkundram.

The program was coordinated by Dr. B. Prabasheela, UBA Coordinator, and Mr. S. Sathiyaraj, Arunkundram Village Coordinator of AVIT. The training session was conducted by Mrs. N. A. Bharathi, Trainer, Peace Trust Skill Development Centre, Chengalpattu.

The program aimed to empower rural women by equipping them with practical skills in paper bag making, thereby enhancing their income-generation opportunities, entrepreneurial abilities, and overall economic status. More than 15 women from Arunkundram village actively participated in the training.

During the session, Mrs. N. A. Bharathi demonstrated the step-by-step process of making paper gift bags, elaborated on suitable sources for raw materials, and guided participants on strategies for online marketing of their finished products.

The event concluded with an interactive Q&A session, during which participants clarified their doubts on paper bag production, and small-scale business management. The program successfully motivated the women to explore self-employment opportunities and contribute to their household income.
